Essays should be placed in one large envelope and delivered to the Advancement office by **Tuesday, March 30, 2010.** Be sure the names of all scholarships for which you are applying are indicated on each essay and on the outer envelope.

Recipients of scholarship awards will be notified by mail at the end of June.
