The Julie Kaye Horn Memorial Art Scholarship was established in September of 1995. The family and friends of Julie Horn have established this fund in loving memory of a beautiful and talented woman. Their wish is to see Julie's spirit live on in the artistic endeavors of an aspiring Mercy Art Department student.

The scholarship is granted to the young woman who best exemplifies the following criteria as determined by the Horn Family in conjunction with the Mercy High School Art Department.

Criteria:

- Financial need
- Currently enrolled in Art at Mercy
- Desire to continue her education beyond high school
- Creative and independent thinking

A candidate is asked to write an essay to describe herself and how she meets the above criteria. The essay must be no more than two pages (written or typed). She must also submit a work of art created by her specifically for this purpose that cannot have been used or previously submitted as an assignment. It may be used for extra credit at the discretion of the Art Department faculty.

Please mark "Julie Kaye Horn Memorial Art Scholarship" **at the top of the page and put your name, address and 2010-2011 grade on the back of the essay.** Enclose the essay in an envelope and submit it along with the art work to the Art Department by **Tuesday, March 30, 2010.**

Recipients of scholarship awards will be notified by mail at the end of June.
