#### Pass the Torch!

Every family is expected to sell at least 35 tickets per student at \$5 per ticket (30 tickets per student for families with multiple students), per your enrollment agreement. Keep in mind this is only the minimum, and we encourage everyone to sell more in support of meeting our goals! Additional tickets will be available in the Reception Area.

## **TICKETS**

### Filling out tickets:

- Each raffle ticket MUST be filled out completely, not just the top ticket.
- Please keep all books STAPLED when you submit them.

## • Money:

- o Ticket stubs (the small part) can only be returned with matching funds, either cash or check.
- Checks must be made out to Mercy High School.
- Please double check your tickets and money to make sure your count is accurate.
- Full payment must accompany each raffle ticket in order to count for awards and our total goal. Please turn in all collection envelopes to your Adviser.

## Turning in your money and tickets:

- o Be sure to fill out the front of the Sweepstakes envelope completely, including your advisor name.
- You must fill out YOUR NAME on the "turned in by" portion of the ticket. Unfortunately, if this is not filled out, you will not be eligible for daily incentive drawings.
- Please return any unused tickets to the Advancement Office.
- Each raffle ticket has a \$5.00 Zerbo's Market Coupon on back great selling point!

# **OUT OF UNIFORM**

- Out of Uniform: Maroon Wristband from your Advisor
  - Wristband must be visible at all times for the student to be out of uniform.
  - If you lose your wristband, you must go to Reception to have a new wristband issued at a cost of \$5.
  - Out of Uniform
    - Preview Week: October 17-21st
    - 11/28 through the end of December
    - 4/17 through the end of the year
  - Eliqibility: 35 tickets/30 tickets for each sister
- Shorts: Orange Circle Sticker from your Advisor
  - Sticker must be affixed to the student's ID to wear shorts.
  - Eligibility: 55 tickets/50 tickets for each sister
- Leggings: Green Circle Sticker from your Advisor
  - Sticker must be affixed to the student's ID to wear shorts
  - Eligibility: 80 or more tickets

### Guidelines:

• It is inappropriate to expose hips, midriffs or cleavage. Leggings, pajama pants, spaghetti straps and rubber flip flops are not allowed.

- Leggings must be worn with a top that covers your bottom. If it does not, you will lose your Leggings Pass and will not be able to earn it back.
- Shorts must be fingertip length or longer.
- The wristband and stickers are your uniform pass and must be visible at all times. Failure to have the required wristband or stickers while out of uniform could result in a detention.

## WINNING CLASS

- The winning class will earn a day off of school (chosen by administration), determined by a combination of spirit points and most raffle tickets sold.
  - Winner is based on a normalized number due to the different sizes in each grade.
