Her passion for Mercy and its long-term success distinguished her career through many roles. As a dedicated math teacher, a skilled and compassionate Principal and President, she was a strong female leader ahead of her time.



Sister Regina personally touched the lives of many and the endowed scholarship established in her name will continue to provide support to students in need. Sister Regina's legacy included a strategic plan and comprehensive site plan which have served as the foundation upon which we build current plans. Education of the "whole young woman" in an excellent environment is the goal of The Board of Trustees as they continue to improve programs and renovate Mercy's facilities. New collaborations giving our students hands on and real life experiences in the community are being designed and pilots established. Most recently, efforts to reimagine and renovate existing spaces have provided immediate improvements thanks to the generosity of donors and hard work from our community.

Plans for an Athletic Agility & Conditioning Center are currently underway. This unique space will be used by student-athletes from all Mercy sports and will take the place of the lower level locker room that has been underutilized for years. To promote collaboration in learning, new mobile furniture is being introduced with the hope that all classrooms can soon have this innovative seating. The Marlin Spirit Shop & Catherine McAuley Tea Parlor will be completed in early 2020 and provide a spot to showcase spiritwear and a comfortable space for students to enjoy a quiet cup of tea. Sister Regina would have truly loved these new special Mercy areas and opportunities.

As we look to the future, we continue to build on Sister Regina's strong leadership, accomplishments and ideals, knowing that God is our center and that today's world needs many more "women who make a difference." Sister Regina lived to "Serve the Lord with gladness" and we thank her, and all of you, for making Mercy possible for our young women and in turn, the world.

In Loving Memory of Sister Regina Marie Doelker '56

September 26, 1938 - August 20, 2019



Thousands of Mercy High graduates across Michigan and the world experienced the loving teaching and leadership of Sister Regina Marie Doelker. Her connection to Mercy High School spanned 7 decades and continued until her death.



Ruth Doelker was a student and 1956 graduate of the Catholic all-girl Our Lady of Mercy High School when it was located at Southfield and W. Outer Drive in Detroit. Inspired by the Sisters of Mercy who taught her, she entered the "Mercies" when she graduated and later taught Mathematics at her alma mater from 1964-74, then heading the Math Department.



She was Mercy High School Principal from 1986-2001 at the current location in Farmington Hills and served as President from 2002-2010. Her contributions through 7 decades are remarkable. Regina's legacy was her ability to personally

connect with and engage people in her life's work. She often remembered birthdays, holy days and holidays with her handwritten notes and no request was too large to ask of herself or others if it was for Mercy. She moved Mercy administratively into a new Principal/President model and she was able to create a long range vision for the school. Through the efforts of a successful capital campaign, the new science wing was created leading to Mercy's STEM initiatives and technology excellence. Under her leadership, sports facilities were improved and the first ever tennis courts were created. She continued to develop endowed scholarships, creating the ability to invite students to attend Mercy who did not have the financial means.

Mercy's current President, Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66 remembers Sister Regina fondly as a teacher, mentor and friend. *"Regina dedicated her life to teaching young women and her legacy challenges us to sustain the important work of Mercy High School. She believed in and lived*

The selection of Mercy High School as an Apple Distinguished School highlights our success as an innovative and compelling learning environment that engages students and provides tangible evidence of academic accomplishment. Mercy has been an Apple Distinguished School since 2013.

Mercy teachers are Apple Teacher certified and each one is supplied with iPad and MacBook Air. Classrooms are equipped with Apple TV and most teachers utilize Apple Classroom. Teachers use interactive apps that allow students to demonstrate their learning in various ways and require projects which are enhanced and transformed by video.

All students utilize iPad and in their freshman year take Mercy's active learning iExplore course which centers around projects that employ engineering principles. iExplore introduces students to STEM experiences while delivering instruction through student-centered activities that focus on problem-solving. Students collaborate and edit each other's work using a variety of note taking, text, video, audio and interactive applications. Most instructional resources and assignments are available through the learning management system Schoology, which also provides integration with apps like PowerSchool and Google Drive.

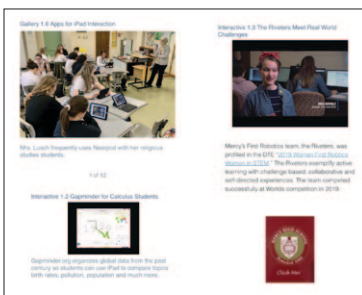
At Mercy, young women have the opportunity to be technology teachers and program innovators through the iPad student tech team called the iWizards and the Robotics Team. The iWizards conduct iPad orientation for all new students, present at tech conferences, provide tech support and media production resources to the Mercy school community.

Mercy also hosts an annual Tech Talk Conference for Educators, has a Mobile APP, iMercy Multi-Touch book, Podcasts featuring Alumnae, three computer labs, a Digital MakerSpace Room, Collaborative Corner, 3-D Printer, and offers coding and AP Computer Science courses. Mercy's technology vision and goals are to cultivate and support active and collaborative learning, nurture creativity, develop STEM curriculum, assist students in becoming adept communicators, promote global citizenship, cultivate critical thinking, and develop safe, responsible digital habits.

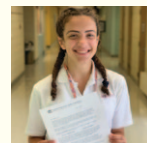

Immaculée Ilibagiza

Rwandan genocide survivor shares her story at Mercy

When Immaculée Ilibagiza came home from college for Easter break in 1994, she did not know that her life would never be the same. Immaculée was born and raised in Rwanda, and lived through the Rwandan genocide as a Tutsi tribe member. At the time, being a Tutsi was a death sentence as they were being targeted for extermination by the Hutu tribe.

For several years, Immaculée's memoir *Left to Tell* has been read and discussed in Mercy's English 9 classes. The book is separated into three parts, each sharing different aspects of both her life and the genocide through her eyes.

In part one, "The Gathering Storm," we learn about Immaculée's family of six, her life growing up in Rwanda, and going to college on a scholarship. As a senior in college, she returned home to celebrate Easter with her family when the Rwandan genocide began. Immaculée was sent by her family to go live in the home of their next door Hutu neighbor, Pastor Murinzi, where she would be safe. This was the last time she saw her family.

Part two of the memoir, "In Hiding," describes the 91 painful days that she spent hiding in Pastor Murinzi's three-by-four-foot bathroom with seven other women. Although a period of unimaginable struggle, the amount of reflection, growth, prayer, and learning that occurred during this time made Immaculée the inspiration she is today.

The memoir concluded with part three, "A New Path," which highlights Immaculée's life after the genocide. Immaculée was taken to a French camp where she learned of the deaths of her family and met her mother's friend who invited Immaculée to move in. Eventually, she started working for the United Nations. The book ends with Immaculée in the jail where her family's killer was held, holding his hands and saying that she forgives him.

Immaculée's story is a powerful reminder of the importance of forgiveness and the freedom in letting go. She is an incredible example of strength, perseverance, faith, and kindness.

But why did her story arrive in the hands of Mercy freshmen?

In hopes to provide a more well-rounded curriculum, Mercy's English department added two memoirs in 2015. *The Glass Castle*, by Jeannette Walls, was introduced to the first semester's 'What does it mean to grow up?' curriculum theme. Whereas, *Left to Tell* was added to enhance the second semester's 'What it means to be human' theme.

Left to Tell offers not only valuable themes, but historical context on a subject that has not received much light. Many compare this genocide to the

Holocaust in Nazi, Germany, but with significantly less coverage.

"After the Jewish holocaust, there was nearly a decade before any first hand literature was released," said English 9 teacher Mr. Steve Morgan. "More time has to pass for important accounts like this to continue to teach and understand the magnitude of these stories."

After Immaculée published her accounts of the genocide through the novel in 2006, other authors have published their own personal testimonies to the tragedy. Novels such as *Love Above All: Forgiveness of a Young Rwandan Genocide Survivor*, by Jean De Dieu Musabyimana, and *A Voice in the Darkness: Memoir of a Rwandan Genocide Survivor*, by Jeanne Celestine Lakin, have also played a role in informing the public about this genocide.

"It is important stories continue to come out," said Mr. Morgan. "With the world being the most divided I have seen it in my lifetime, you have to remember it happened there, it can happen anywhere."

It is because of this divide in the world right now that makes these stories so important. Stories of faith and forgiveness in times of adversity continue to inspire and bring hope to all of those who read them.

Immaculée has made the darkest moments of her life into a universal tale of compassion. Despite no person in our building having ever faced nearly the same threats or fear, so many girls continue to connect with her story.

"When I first read *Left to Tell*, I was incredibly inspired," said junior Grace Nieto. "Immaculée taught me that whenever you're facing a problem, the strength of God will get you through [it]. This book really changed my world view and my life."

Immaculée's story is one that displays how God worked in her life, and the story of how Immaculée came to Mercy is no different.

Kerry Kurowski, the mother of senior Faye Stork, decided to read the novel *Left to Tell* when her daughter was assigned to read it in class her freshman year, and the book changed her life.

Two years later, Mrs. Kurowski started a new job with a Michigan-based religious talent management group. One day during a meeting, she discovered that the group handles all of Immaculée's travel and events.

"I just started crying in the meeting," Mrs. Kurowski said. Now, she works closely with Immaculée and is a part of helping spread her message of faith across the globe through her work with the company.



Throughout her time of working with Immaculée, Mrs. Kurowski has told her about Mercy and how great it would be for her to visit the students. During the summer, it was discovered that Immaculée had some availability during October, and the date was set for her to come to Mercy.

Because the book had such an impact on Mrs. Kurowski, it was important for her to use this incredible opportunity she had been given and spread Immaculée's message even further.

"Mercy has been so good to my daughter," said Mrs. Kurowski. "I wanted to figure out a way to give back and I couldn't think of a better way to say 'thank you' than to bring Immaculée to the Mercy community."

The anticipation surrounding Immaculée's arrival to Mercy was so incredible because students could not wait to meet the woman they all felt a personal connection to. Immaculée's warm and humorous demeanor took students by surprise. She explained how forgiveness has freed her to live without the weight of death on her shoulders. Although Mercy students may never live to endure tragedy as devastating as Immaculée's, she reminded the Mercy community that our faith bonds us together.

"Inside we are all the same," she said. "We have the same Father, and how he works in [our] hearts, I think people can find themselves through that. Whatever problem you have, [even if it's] something you're going through with a friend, it's the same rosary [and] the same God we talk to."

Immaculée's personality reflects everything she stands for: love and acceptance. When asked what advice she would give to any Mercy students who doubt their faith, she became reflective.

"It is so sad when you are doubting your faith—doubting that there is someone with you always," Immaculée said. "I have gone through it, but now I feel like what I always wake up to is more faith."

Immaculée encourages anyone experiencing troubles with their faith to continue to seek truth and never give up. She believes that prayer is the most powerful tool anyone can use while finding their faith, specifically the rosary.

"Ask questions and don't settle," she said. "The prayers we say are like water you put on [a] flower. If you do not [pray], the flower is doomed to die."

Mercy is blessed to count Isabel and Larry Smith as two of our strongest supporters. We are grateful for the opportunity to honor them with this award.

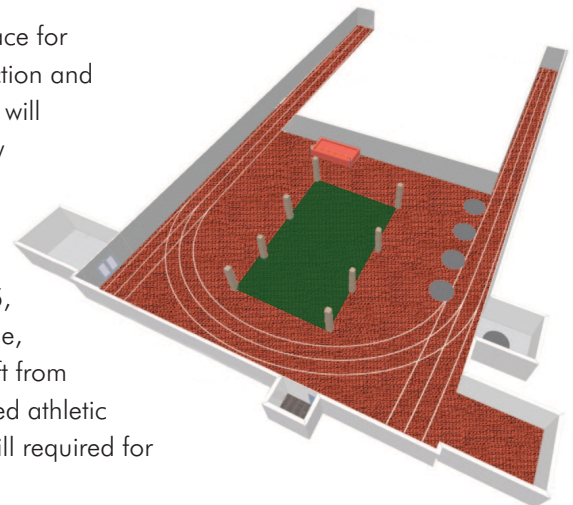


New Athletic Training Facility

Mercy's Athletic Department has begun a project in the lower level. This transformation will enhance self-confidence and student-athlete success across all sports through disciplined work and improved conditioning and agility. Members of the Mercy community volunteered hundreds of hours of service to remove hardware, lockers, and concrete platforms from the basement.

The new facility provides approximately 8,000 square feet of year-round space for calisthenics, bio-metric and bio-mechanical work, sport-specific skills instruction and practice and a myriad of other conditioning and agility activities. The facility will also provide two 50-meter tracks along the exterior walls. These tracks allow aerobic conditioning, speed and agility work and technical training in an indoor environment.

Special thanks to Carla LaFave O'Malley '70 and Judy Herzog (Christine '05, Natalie '08) for hosting an incredibly successful fundraising event. At this time, we have raised over \$125,000 for this effort, which includes a \$110,000 gift from a longtime Mercy supporter. These funds allow for the purchase of specialized athletic flooring and the renovation of an existing bathroom. Significant funds are still required for new LED lighting, security and safety features, and other athletic equipment.

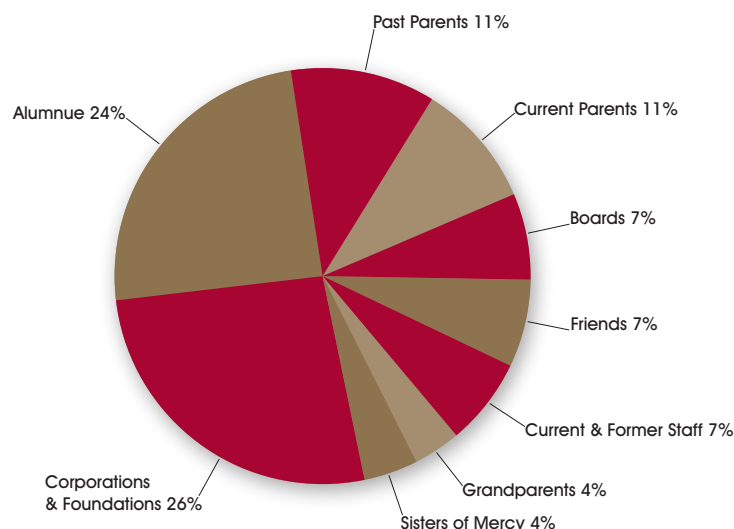
