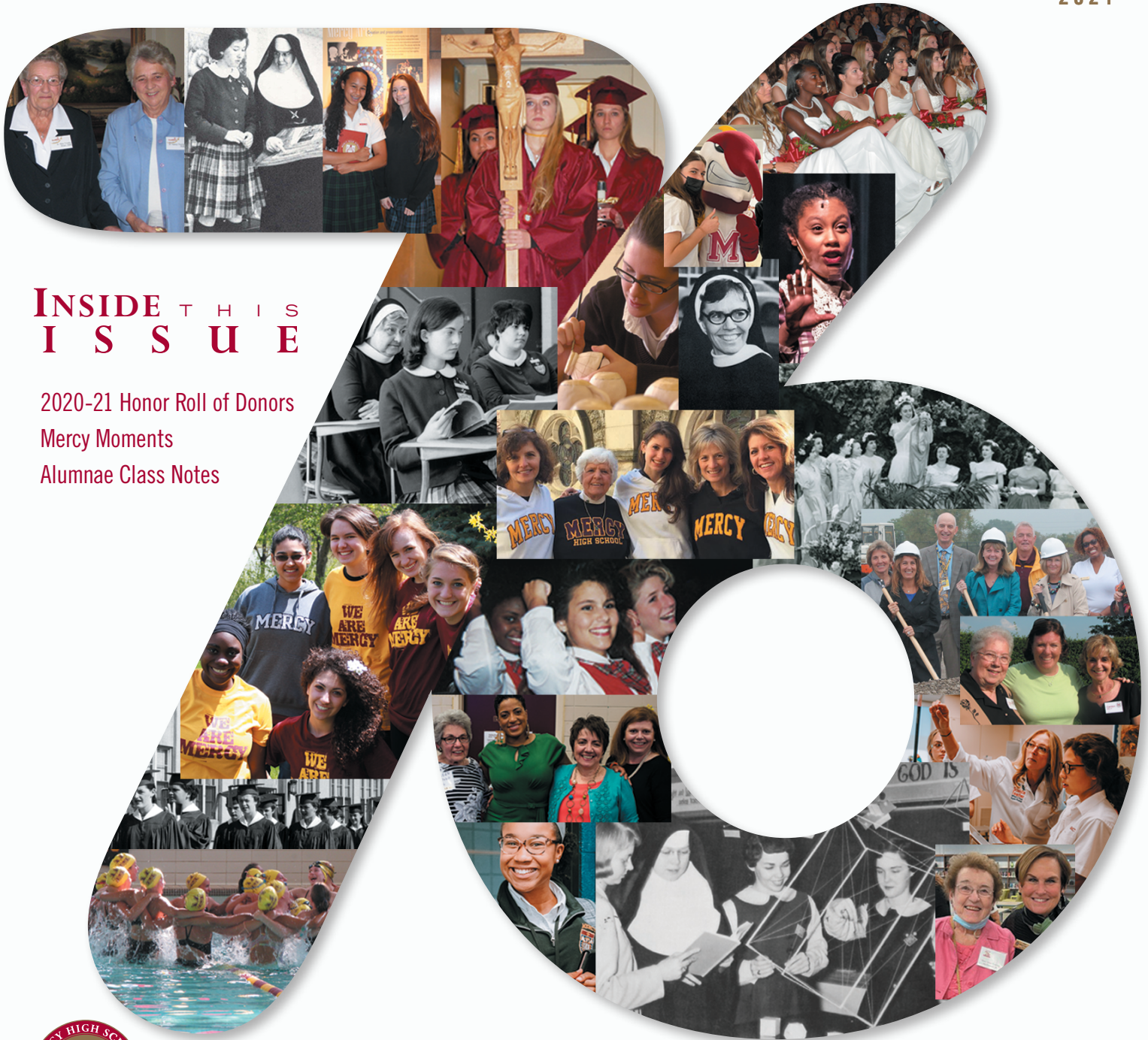

Mercy High School has been blessed with two beautiful campuses: from 1945-1965 Our Lady of Mercy was located in Detroit and when enrollment grew, the new campus was built in Farmington Hills. If you walk the halls of the building today, you will see photos, doors and stained glass windows from the Detroit campus, paying tribute to our rich history.

Throughout the years, Mercy High School has continued to enhance the curriculum to ensure that students receive a strong college preparatory education steeped in Catholic faith. Extracurricular activities and athletics round out a young woman's experience at Mercy. We currently boast 19 sports and over 40 clubs in our effort to educate the whole young woman.

We are incredibly proud to be a part of Mercy Education. On pages 6-7, you will see new Core Values & Profile of the Graduate that will guide all Mercy institutions in ensuring Catherine McAuley and the Sisters of Mercy vision lives on. Together, Mercy will continue to thrive.

The mission of educating women who make a difference includes providing scholarships for those who need assistance to receive a Mercy High School education. We are grateful to the Sisters of Mercy who established the first ever endowed fund at the school. Our appreciation grows with each new endowed fund that is added by alumnae, parents and friends.

Sisters of Mercy Farmington Hills Campus Update



As the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas engaged in a “Journey of Oneness” over the past several years, the Sisters recognized that all properties owned by the order were no longer needed. Sadly, the former Detroit Province holding was one of such sites. As a result, the Sisters recently sold their 30-acre campus adjacent to the High School to a senior housing developer. Plans have been made for all Sisters formerly living “across the pond” from the high school. A few Sisters remain next door and will eventually have the option to move into the new housing development when completed. Many other Sisters moved to the neighborhoods of White Lake, MI or Freemont, OH or continue to live independently.

During the transition, the Sisters have generously given Mercy High School some treasures as part of their move. The Cross which hung in the small Chapel above the altar where the Sisters more recently attended daily Mass and prayer is now used at Mercy High School Masses. It is stunning and helps to make the Auditorium a sacred space.

The Sisters also announced a wonderful gift to the High School - the 35-acre nature conservancy containing the pond, prayer labyrinth, stations of the cross and shrine to Our Lady of Mercy which will be deeded to the school this winter.

Mercy students will continue to benefit from the conservancy for years to come as outdoor space for prayer and meditation, science learning as well as a cross country route. Mercy President Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66 shared a tribute to the Sisters of Mercy during the President's Reception on Mercy Day September 24 and Sister Judith Frikker '67 announced the gift at that time.

In addition to these gifts, we are grateful to the Sisters of Mercy for many things, among them:

The visionary leadership of extraordinary Mercy women beginning with Catherine McAuley who said, “let us fit young people for earth without unfitting them for heaven.” Such words were the tenants of a value-centered education in the Catholic tradition which included an option for the poor, especially women and children, and a compassionate presence.

Locally this vision meant the opening of the Detroit Our Lady of Mercy High School and then the move to the Farmington Hills campus, which allowed for expansion. Hallmarks of a Mercy education are a cutting-edge curriculum, unique schedule, technology, robust options in athletics and extracurricular activities and excellent fine and performing arts programs.

Practical business sense, conservative finances. Catherine McAuley recognized the importance of finances in successful ministry. The Sisters of Mercy provide for students who cannot afford a Mercy education through an endowment that generates 16 scholarships each year. The high school has a solid financial foundation.

Strong central leadership for the schools. Mercy is governed by MESA (Mercy Education Systems of America) who provide monthly cohort meetings, yearly conferences and training for staff, administration and the Board of Trustees. Mercy carries on the Charism of the Sisters of Mercy evaluated through an annual stewardship review, assuring that lay persons understand and are dedicated to the Critical Concerns and that the school ministries live them.



President's Award for Transformational Leadership 2020 and 2021

The President's Reception was held in the evening of Mercy Day, September 24th, to honor Mercy donors. Mercy President, Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66, presented the President's Award for Transformational Leadership to the 2020 Recipients, **The Sisters of Mercy**, and the 2021 Recipients **Paul and Gretchen Swanson**.

The Sisters of Mercy continue to bless Mercy High School, as a sponsored ministry, with their dedication to Tuition Assistance, by providing opportunities to learn and grow in faith and by serving as members of the Board. Through the Mercy Education System of the Americas, we are proud to be connected to other Mercy schools throughout the country and internationally.

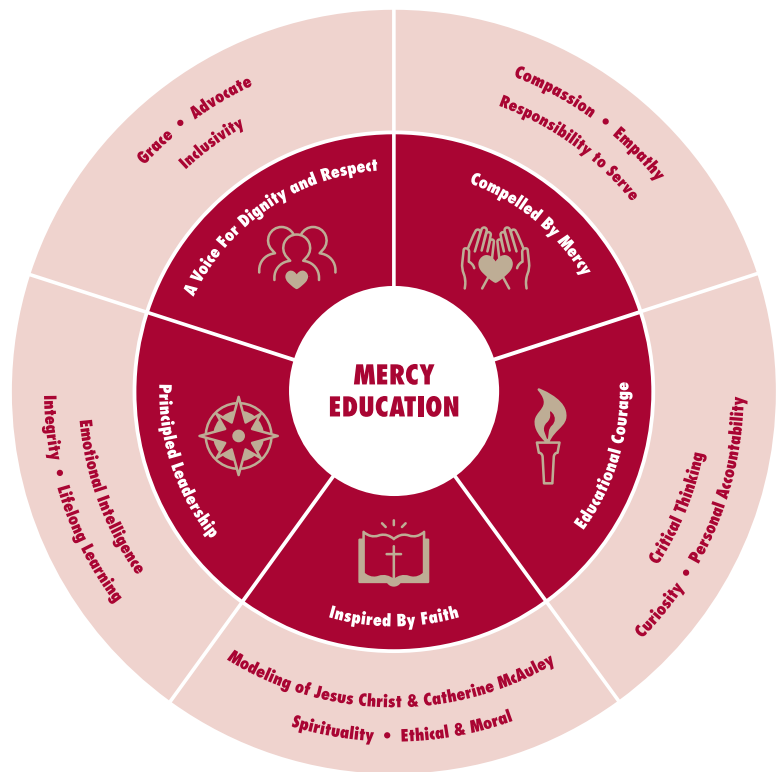
A Voice For Dignity and Respect

Dr. Patricia Petrella Nouhan '81 accepts her 2021 Distinguished Alumna Award from Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66 in the Catherine McAuley Tea Parlor.

Patricia Petrella Nouhan, M.D. '81 exemplifies the Mercy values in her job as a physician, her role as residency director, her volunteer work and in her personal life.

Since 1994, Dr. Nouhan has served as an Attending Physician with the Department of Emergency Medicine at St. John Hospital and Medical Center (SJH&MC) in Detroit, Michigan. She intentionally chose to work for a Catholic health system because she wants her place of work to be in alignment with her values. The number one mission of Ascension Health is care for the poor. In the emergency room, patients receive treatment, whether or not they have the means to pay. SJH&MC cares for a large population of indigent patients who now live on Detroit's east side since downtown's gentrification.

Dr. Nouhan '81 also demonstrates a commitment to teaching and training resident physicians to be the best in Emergency Medicine. Despite the pressures of choosing and training new physicians for the residency program, she continues to devote her time and energy to these young doctors so that they gain solid experience and confidence in their skills to better serve their patients. Her role is to develop and implement policy to ensure that Californians with developmental disabilities have the opportunity to lead independent, productive lives in their community of choice.

Lauren is a commissioner appointed by Governor Gavin Newsom to the California Commission on the Status of Women and Girls. The Commission on the Status of Women and Girls works in a culturally inclusive manner to promote equality and justice for all women and girls by advocating

on their behalf with the Governor, the Legislature, and other public policymakers. She also serves on the board for STAND! for Families Free of Violence, and Contra Costa Economic Opportunity Council.

She is also a graduate of American University, the George Washington University School of Political Management, and the 2019 Class of Emerge California. Lauren serves on the Mercy CORE Steering Committee, and as former Mercy soccer, track, and cross-country athlete, she co-chairs the athletics sub-committee. She is also a former board member of Girls Leadership, 2020 Women's Foundation of California Women's Policy Institute Fellow, and was recently named to the "4 Black Policy Movers & Shakers You Should Know". Lauren lives in Sacramento with her partner Kyle and very cute puppy Dolfo.

United States District Court Judge Jia M. Cobb '98

During her Mercy days, Jia was a spirited Mercy cheerleader and valedictorian/salutatorian finalist.

In June 2021, the White House announced their nomination of Attorney Jia Cobb for United States District Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. On October 27, 2021, she received confirmation from the United States Senate. With her confirmation, Judge Cobb is now only the fourth Black woman ever appointed to this Court.

Jia received her B.A. from Northwestern University in 2002 and J.D. cum laude from Harvard Law School where she served as Coordinating Editor of the Harvard Law Review.

After graduating, she clerked for Judge Diane Wood on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit and joined the Public Defender Service for the District of Columbia. In 2010, she became a Partner at Relman Colfax, where she practices civil litigation and civil rights law. Jia currently lives in the Washington D.C. area with her son, Ricky Bush.

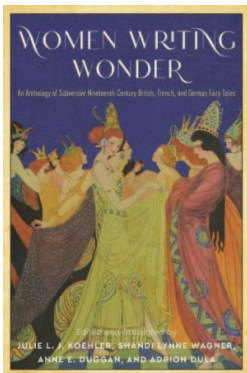

When the Reid family lost their father, William, and contacted Mercy about establishing a fund in memory of their parents, they didn't know that they would be fulfilling a wish. The family was surprised to learn that their father had contacted Mercy years ago about honoring the memory of his wife of 53 years, Roseanne, a former teacher at Mercy.

The donation from the estate after William's passing in 2021 made that wish a reality when the family established the **Roseanne C. Reid and William A. Reid Memorial Endowed Scholarship**.

Roseanne and William had a high regard for a quality education for themselves and their children. Mary Lynne '71 and Catherine '75 attended Mercy High School and their son William graduated from University of Detroit Jesuit High School.

Roseanne earned both a bachelor's and master's degree while raising three children. Her teaching career spanned 30 years, shaping the lives of thousands of young students. She taught Literature, History and Economics at St. Mary's of Redford and Mercy High School.

Her sister remembered Roseanne as a "devoted wife and mother, a gifted leader, a talented teacher, and a shining example of how we should exploit our God-given talents and energy to make the world a better place while humbly recognizing potential and working to bring out the best in others."

Their children, Mary Lynne, Catherine and William recall; "while in high school, when most of us would rather complain about our teachers, we all took exceptional pride in hearing our peers compliment Mom as one of the best teachers they ever had in high school."

Roseanne's husband, William, received both his undergraduate and MBA degrees from University of Detroit Mercy and had a 30-year career with Ford Motor Company. Volunteerism and philanthropy were very important to him, and he served as Chair of the Parents Club and the annual fundraiser at Mercy for many years.

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER

If you are 70 1/2 or older, you may consider the gift of an IRA charitable rollover. Rather than withdraw monies from your IRA and incur both income and capital gains tax, you may transfer up to \$100,000 from your IRA to our school and not be subject to deduction limits on charitable gifts. After age 72, your "required minimum distribution" or a portion, may be directed to Mercy High School. All you need to do is contact your IRA plan administrator to make a gift from your IRA to our school.

APPRECIATED STOCK

Rather than pay capital gains tax on your appreciated stock, you may choose to gift stock to Mercy High School. With your gift, you avoid capital gains tax, earn a larger tax deduction while providing critical financial support to your favorite school!

DONOR ADVISED FUND

Some families are choosing to create a Donor Advised Fund, a kind of charitable investment account. If you have a Donor Advised Fund, please consider giving a gift - perhaps even a recurring yearly gift - to Mercy High School.

Before you decide to make a gift to Mercy High School, please consult your attorney, tax advisor or financial planner, to determine whether such a gift makes sense given your particular circumstance.

DEADLINE

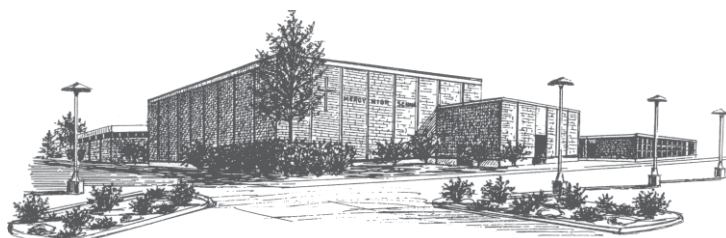
Gifts from an IRA, appreciated stock, or from a checking or investment account, must be received by Mercy High School by December 15 to allow for processing by December 31. Pursuant to IRS regulations, gifts must be withdrawn in the calendar year of which they are made, or the distribution will be counted in the following year.
