# Sattler settles in

Mrs. Patricia Sattler strolled through slippery, freshly waxed halls, following closely behind her tour guide, trying to take in every detail, on the first of July. Although summer was still in full swing, Mrs. Sattler was already getting settled into her new position. As she navigated her way through the halls of Mercy, she imagined how the atmosphere would change once the first kilt entered the doors. She wondered how students would react to their new principal, and eventually found that she was welcomed into the Mercy community with open arms.

“[At first] people would ask me where I’m from and I would say, ‘Gabriel Richard,’” said Mrs. Sattler. “After just a few weeks, I would say, ‘Well, I’m from Mercy.’”

Mercy President Dr. Cheryl Kreger led the search to find a new principal. She sent out a poll to Mercy parents and alumni to determine what qualities in a principal were most important. Based on those results and a rigorous interview process, Mrs. Sattler was chosen to be the new principal.

Mrs. Sattler worked as the Dean of Students for four years at Gabriel Richard in Riverview.

Although she enjoyed her time there, Mrs. Sattler was excited to join a community that emphasizes female empowerment, as well as technology.

“[Mercy] attracted me very much because of the technology program,” said Mrs. Sattler. “To take that strength of women and challenging women with educational technology seemed like a perfect fit [for me].”

Originally, Mrs. Sattler studied language, with hopes of becoming an interpreter. After realizing that this career path required computer experience, she returned to school to earn a computer degree and was introduced to the world of technology. She was quickly hired by a computer company, where she worked as a

programmer for 14 years. Despite her lengthy commitment, she said she never fully enjoyed her job.

It wasn’t until she was hired by Electronic Data Systems (EDS) as a technical trainer that she realized her love for education. EDS was a global corporation that trained people from all over the world in computer technology and use.

Since then, Mrs. Sattler has emphasized the importance of technology education for all students, not just for those interested in STEM careers.

Mrs. Sattler wants to become a resource to help students and staff reach their goals.

“[I want to understand] what is important to this community, what works for this community and how this community wants to move forward,” she said. “Then I can be a supporting role in the team to bring it forward so that I’m really value added.”

According to Mrs. Sattler, communication is key. She sought out different staff members to learn their perspectives of the school.

“I really believe in open communication,” said Mrs. Sattler. “I’ve tried to communicate with people so that I can learn more about Mercy and Mercy’s culture.”

“[Mrs. Sattler] came in over the summer and really wanted to know Mercy,” said Dean of Students Mrs. Eleasha Tarplin. “She made her

way around and did multiple tours with multiple people to get a feel for Mercy in the perspective of different peoples’ eyes.”

Mrs. Sattler continues to make an effort to connect with students and their parents to fully understand the community.

“It has been her goal to meet students and to be engaged with students; she’s really worked hard at it,” said Dr. Kreger. “We’ve had coffees in the morning [so she can meet] with parents. We’ve made sure she’s had an opportunity to speak and send out communications so people get to know her.”

The freshwomen and Link Crew leaders had the opportunity to meet their new principal at freshwomen orientation.

“Mrs. Sattler got involved in getting to know students right away and I think it was awesome of her to make an appearance at freshwomen orientation,” said senior Link Crew leader Anna Wiseley. “I think it definitely helped the girls feel more comfortable knowing their principal is so friendly and involved.”

When she isn’t busy at school, Mrs. Sattler can be found playing with her rescue puppy Daisy or visiting her three kids who are in college and beyond. One of her favorite vacation destinations is Washington D.C. where she enjoys testing out new restaurants and exploring the area. She especially enjoys walking around the different Embassies and taking in different ways of life.

As she gets to know the student body, Mrs. Sattler said she is excited by the potential she sees. She has also noticed the welcoming kindness that has made her feel part of the Mercy family.

“There hasn’t been a student that I’ve gone by that hasn’t given me a smile and a welcome,” said Mrs. Sattler. “That is very inspiring for me.”

# PRIEST with a passion

Entering Mercy’s auditorium for the first time, Father Jerry Brzezinski enthusiastically greeted an unfamiliar student body. After introducing himself, Fr. Jerry jumped right into the Mass in his own unique way. Rather than doing the usual opening prayers, Fr. Jerry instead began Mass by encouraging student participation. He asked each individual grade what they would like to pray for this school year. Students called out their responses, tentatively at first, but with more and more confidence as time went on.

Even as Mass progressed, Fr. Jerry continually included the congregation in the service, especially through relating his homily to everyday struggles students face. At the end of Mass, Fr. Jerry left the auditorium both satisfied with the first impression he made and eager for the rest of his ministry here at Mercy.

“He brought a new energy into the building and I think he enlightened our whole school and is making positive changes for the upcoming school year,” said sophomore Keiley Black.

As Mercy’s new part-time chaplain, this is the type of effect Fr. Jerry hopes to have on students. This should not be an issue due to his extensive history not only as a dynamic priest but also as a Catholic educator.

“I’ve been in education all my life,” said Fr. Jerry. “I was director of religious education for eight years in the Archdiocese of Detroit. I was in campus ministry for 32 years, so ... to be a part of the Mercy community was a very positive thing.”

Fr. Jerry joined the Mercy community with help from the pastoral ministry team, especially Mrs. Andrea Kowalyk.

“We wanted a priest that was consistently here so that the girls could form a relationship with him instead of having visiting priests all the time,” said Mrs. Kowalyk.

Both she and Fr. Jerry also hope that his availability will allow students to feel comfortable to ask him questions and approach him with concerns.

One way he plans to accomplish this is through visiting religious studies classes to simply talk with students and answer any of their questions. He would also like to pursue more Reconciliation opportunities, and meet with students to get their views on the liturgy so that they have even more chances to connect with their faith.

In fact, Fr. Jerry has already made one change in the way Mercy celebrates Mass: moving the altar from up on the stage to down on

the floor where students sit. He did this to encourage Mercy students to participate more actively in Mass. This change was noticed and appreciated by many students, including sophomore Grace Fadool.

“As a student that sits in the second row, I now get to be very engaged with the priest,” she said. “It was really nice to have him come closer to us like he was one of us and not above us.”

Fr. Jerry’s journey to priesthood began in childhood and continued into his young adult years.

“My uncle was a priest and I saw in him something that was good in what he did and how he related to people,” said Fr. Jerry.

Although he had inklings from a young age, he didn’t firmly decide to become a priest until his third year at St. Mary’s College. At that point, something clicked inside Fr. Jerry that convinced him that he wanted to dedicate his life to God. Once he made this decision, he poured his heart and soul into his ministry.

Fr. Jerry didn’t make this journey to the priesthood on his own, of course. One significant influence was his Catholic school education at Guardian Angels in Clawson and St. Mary’s Preparatory School in Orchard Lake. Being fully immersed in his faith at Catholic schools drew him closer to both God and priesthood.

“In the Catholic school setting, there was a lot of support,” said Fr. Jerry. “We had Dominicans at Guardian Angels so there was a lot of modeling that came from the staff along with the Dominican religious.”

Because of his background in Catholic education, Fr. Jerry truly understands the importance of Catholic schools at all levels.

“[The benefit] is the faith dimension and the values that the Catholic school provides just [through] its environment,” he said. “That was part of everything we did. It was always [looked at] through the lens of our faith.”

Most importantly, because of his background and experience, Fr. Jerry recognizes the significance of his new position of part-time chaplain at Mercy.

“[It’s important for students] to be able to connect more directly with an individual who’s going to be a consistent with the community, with the students, with the faculty, and therefore be able to build a relationship just like a parish.”

All Mercy teachers are Apple Teacher certified and each one is supplied with iPad and MacBook Air. Classrooms are equipped with Apple TVs and many teachers utilize Apple Classroom. All students utilize iPad and in their freshman year take a Design Foundations course where they learn multimedia skills in digital photography, video, animation, web design and slide presentations. Mercy also hosts an annual Tech Talk Conference for Educators, has a Mobile APP, iMercy Multi-Touch book, Podcasts featuring Alumnae, various courses available on iTunes U, three computer labs, a Digital MakerSpace Room and offers a coding course.

Paperless workflow and grading prevails at Mercy. Students collaborate and edit each other’s work using text, video, and audio applications. Most instructional resources are available through the learning management system Schoology, which also provides integration with apps like Powerschool and Google Drive.

At Mercy, young women have the opportunity to be technology teachers and program innovators through the iPad student tech team called the iWizards and the Riveters First Robotics Team. The iWizards conducted iPad orientation for all new students and created an iTunes U course of iPad Tips & Tricks to provide training and resources to the Mercy school community. They are currently advancing a new global collaboration project at “The International Student Tech Team Hub.”



Mercy’s technology vision and goals are to assist students in becoming adept communicators, promote global citizenship, support collaborative learning, cultivate critical thinking and develop safe, responsible digital habits.

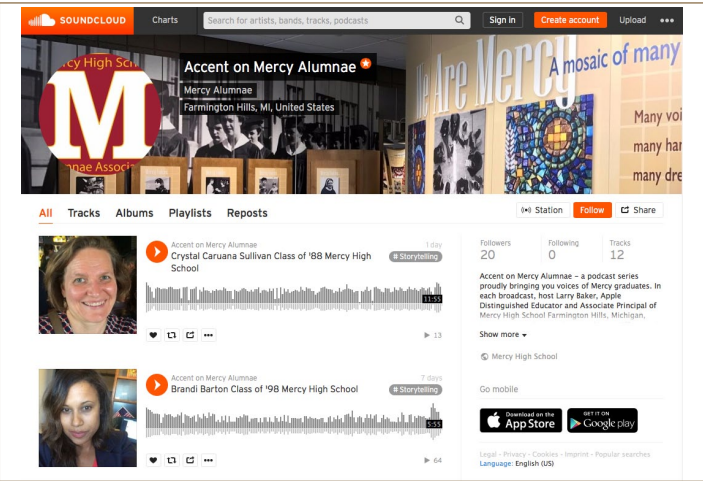

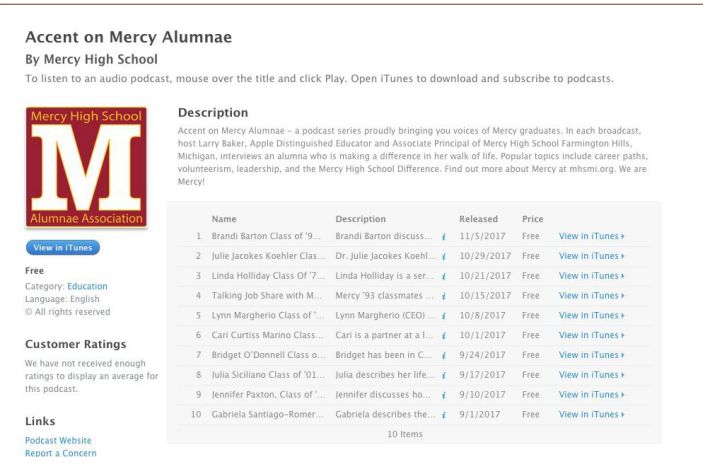

## Bill and Mary Ann Valade Honored at President's Reception

Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66 was proud to honor Bill and Mary Ann Valade with the President's Award for Transformational Leadership during the 2017 Reunion Weekend. Bill and Mary Ann are a remarkable couple with a long-standing history with Mercy High School. Two of Bill's sisters attended Mercy– Sister Rita Marie Valade, RSM '72 and Patricia Valade Dalrick '69. Bill and Mary Ann are proud parents of two Mercy alumnae, Mary Jane Valade '97 and Suzanne Valade Richardt '02.



Bill served on the Mercy Board of Trustees from 2007-2016, leaving a significant legacy, most especially during his final term as Chairman of the Board. He then continued his service as the liaison to Mercy High School from the Sisters of Mercy West Midwest Education Sponsorship Council which then transitioned into his current role as a founding member of the Board of Directors of MESA (Mercy Education System of the Americas).

Over the years, Bill and Mary Ann served as committee members and advisors on a variety of Mercy Advancement endeavors. Not only have they generously provided significant financial support for many projects, they have also shared

important insight and perspective on these initiatives.

Mary Ann gave a poignant reflection on the legacy of Catherine McAuley and Mercy:

*"Catherine McAuley offered a cup of Irish tea to comfort others. A cup of fresh and pure green tea is like the outpouring of your artistic talents, or one's sharing the Spirit of God through campus ministry or to one's neighbor. It is like respecting human dignity AND having an attitude of mercy toward others."*

*A cup of aged black tea is like the grounding framework that is taught here at Mercy – of math, sciences, debate, sport, or the strong conviction to work for social justice and to make others aware of injustice or keeping Mercy High School alive by your tangible support or making yourself useful to the Board.*

It can be a blend of studying languages, literature, medical or technical subjects that all flower into global activities like researching and promoting Options for the Poor, Advocating for Water Equity and Immigrants, or helping get the tickets and coat check and auction items all in order, or running the clock at 4 years of basketball games.*

Along with Bill's sisters, the Valades created the Rita & William Valade Sr. Endowed Fund in 2011. This fund was established in order to annually support a Mercy student with financial need who values education, has a strong faith and who wishes to become a woman who makes a difference in the world.

Bill and Mary Ann are the third recipients of this prestigious award. Past recipients include William C. Young (2015) and Rita Dilworth Lewry '77 and Thomas Lewry (2016).

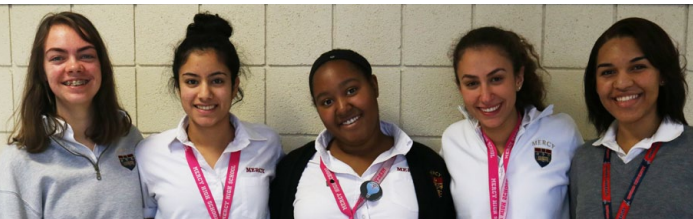

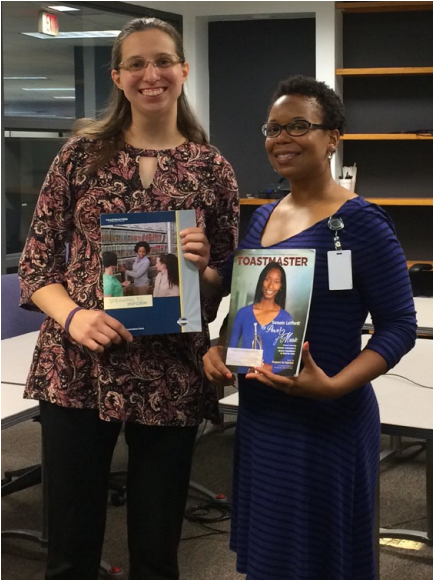
