

Félicitations Madame Campbell!

The Michigan World Language Association (MIWLA) presented the Barbara Ort-Smith Award to Joyce Smetanka Campbell. This is the most prestigious award a world languages professional can receive in the state of Michigan! It honors those who have shown a strong commitment to the profession, manifesting itself in leadership and the promotion of excellence in world language education.

Madame Campbell received her BA from Michigan State University in French Education and her MA from the University of Michigan in Curriculum Design and Instruction She is Mercy's senior French language teacher and Chair of the World Languages Department. As chair, Joyce leads a vibrant team that offers French, Spanish, and Latin courses at all levels, including Advancement Placement. Joyce was formerly an adjunct professor at Mercy College in Detroit and an adult education instructor.

Joyce is known for her innovative programs - including courses on French theater, opera, art and architecture, poetry and literature - and is an advocate for technology in language education. She was instrumental in the installation of two language labs at Mercy. She launched Passport to France: An Immersion Experience, which proved to be successful in introducing middle school students to French as well as Mercy High School. She regularly conducts student field trips to special exhibits at the Detroit Institute of Arts and local French restaurants, and she

celebrates National French Week, focusing on a region of the Francophone world with guest speakers and cultural explorations of cuisine, art, cinema, music, and dance.

Joyce is especially recognized for the high academic standards she establishes and the leadership skills she develops among students, many of whom have pursued successful careers in government, law, business, and education using the French competence they achieved in her programs. Her efforts were recognized in 2009 when she was honored as Mercy High School's Teacher of the Year. Her contributions to the profession include her affiliations with the American Council of Teachers of Foreign Languages, the American Association of Teachers of French, the Oakland World Language Advisory Council, the French Institute Alliance Française of Michigan, and the Michigan World Language Association. Joyce has worked closely with the American Council on International Studies (ACIS) in Paris and the U.S. in coordinating trips for students and adults to all regions of France and other Francophone countries.

She truly believes that travel, living and studying abroad lead to a greater understanding of other cultures and a greater sense of our shared humanity. Madame Campbell is an inspiration to many and well deserving of this lifetime achievement award!



Mercy Scholarships Provide Lasting Legacy

Scholarships support the education of Mercy students while providing a legacy for sustainable tuition assistance and long-term viability of Mercy High School. Currently 34 endowed scholarships have been established at Mercy and provide a way for alumnae, parents and donors to have a connection with Mercy students.

Donors who establish endowed scholarships at \$25,000 or more, or make a long-term commitment to financial assistance, are invited to attend the annual Circle of Mercy Reception. Donors, student recipients, and the student's family gather for a meal and listen to a scholarship donor and student recipient who share their perspectives on the program. Scholarship donors are provided with a yearly note from the student, allowing them to keep in touch.

Recent endowed scholarships include:

Andrea Jackson Memorial Scholarship - Established in 2016 to honor the memory of Mercy alumna Andrea Jackson '96. Students who have an interest in the arts and possess an effervescent personality will be considered for this scholarship.

Maynard HOPE Scholarship - Established in 2016 by Mercy Alumna Nadine Frazier Maynard '63 and her son Christopher Maynard. Both want to thank God for all the blessings received in their lives and "to give back." Both feel that HOPE is very much needed for a better future for all God's people. And both believe that to invest in education, specifically the education of young women, is a way to achieve this hope in the future. So, in the tradition of Catherine McAuley and the Sisters of Mercy, this scholarship will help educate a deserving young woman who possesses a love of learning, who will lead and serve with mercy and compassion.

The Sarin and Shepanek Family Scholarship - Established in 2017 to honor Mercy graduates in the Sarin and Shepanek families including: Lisa Shepanek Berken '76, Suzanne Sarin Shepanek '79, Anne Giroux Sarin '82, Lisabeth Sarin '86, and Catie Sarin '08. The scholarship will provide financial aid to a young woman who exemplifies the Mercy values and demonstrates financial need.

Diana George Jacokes Endowed Fund - Established in 2017 to honor the memory of alumna Diana George Jacokes '67 by husband Paul Jacokes and the Jacokes children. Its purpose is to support the education of young women at Mercy High School. Diana would be pleased to know that the scholarship established in her name is helping a student who reflects the values that she cherished in her classmates while at Mercy High School: intelligence, kindness, good humor and generosity of spirit.

Carolyn and Robert Witte Endowed Scholarship - Established in 2018 to honor former Mercy Principal Carolyn Behringer Witte '67 and her husband Bob Witte. The scholarship will assist students whose families may need a modicum of financial assistance to make a Mercy education feasible.

Herbert and Dolores Delaney Memorial Scholarship - Established in 2018 to honor the memory of Herbert and Dolores Delaney, parents of Dr. Cheryl Delaney Kreger '66. The purpose of the fund is to support tuition for a student in financial need. Herbert and Dolores Delaney were products of 12 years of Catholic education, including Dolores receiving education from the Sisters of Mercy at St. Andrews School in Saginaw. They sacrificed so their three daughters could have the same opportunity to receive a Catholic education at Our Lady of Mercy High School.

Jackie Michon Scholarship (expendable) - Established in 2018 to honor the memory of Jackie Michon '02. Recipients of the Jackie Michon Scholarship have financial need and want to receive a Mercy education. Characteristics of the recipients should be hard-working, will take all that Mercy has to offer and have a friendly, all-inclusive positive attitude and outlook on life.





ENDOWED FUNDS

Endowed Funds can also support a Mercy department to allow for enhanced experiences for students by providing long-term support.

In the summer of 2016, the Nancy Malinowski Endowed Fund for Athletics was established, and the income on the investment of that fund will be used to support the extensive athletics programs available to Mercy students.

Similar funds may be created for a particular academic department or extracurricular program, such as the creation of a STEM endowed fund to support Math and Science Departments, which is currently underway.

An endowed fund may be established with a minimum gift of \$25,000 and funded in a variety of ways: a single gift; a series of gifts over several years; or a planned gift from the estate of the donor. Contact the Advancement Office at advancement@mhsmi.org or 248-893-3538.

Carol and Bill founded the McNish Family Foundation in 2003 to provide resources for need-based scholarships and grants for young people to be successful in high school and beyond. The McNish Family Foundation has supported Mercy students through tuition assistance and the Mary Jean Shannon Memorial Scholarship. Family member Mary Jean Nilan Shannon graduated in 1950. Carol, Bill and Mary Jean's daughters Maura Shannon '76 and Megan Shannon Curoe '85 serve on the Foundation Board.



We will also make note of our members' generosity in publications such as our MOSAIC magazine and Annual Report. Of course, donors have the option of remaining anonymous if desired.


