- 3. Willing to work with Mid American Pom camps and officials.
- 4. Run Kids pom pom camp.
- 5. Schedule practices, clinics, and camps.
- 6. Setting up performances at Football and Basketball games.

- 7. Demonstrate contemporary knowledge of the sport and an ability to cultivate new skills with students through drills, sequenced plays and encouragement on and off the field.
- 8. Establish clear expectations and consequences; deliver criticism in a manner that upholds the dignity of each athlete while maintaining high expectations.
- 9. Continue to grow professionally by attending seminars and clinics.
- 10. Establish a positive relationship with coaches, athletes, parents, officials, and community members.
- 11. Attend all meetings for school, league, and state.
