

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Never in my wildest imagination did I think a simple social media query would have led to this amazing opportunity for Mercy Performing Arts. In my search for our fall play this season, having already secured *Frozen*, I was on the hunt for something with strong female characters and a theme of sisterhood, to round out our season. I reached out to an amazing group of theatre teachers for suggestions, and, as luck would have it, local playwright Tracy Wells contacted me offering some of her work, including the *Angels of Bataan* World Premiere. Considering the play was still in the initial stages of development, we had to wait patiently for a script, but I immediately became invested in the true story of these exceptional women. I didn't explore other options, as I had faith that this would be the perfect piece for us.

Fortunately, after a few months, I received a draft of Act One, which left me teary eyed. I knew immediately that this was a great fit for our actors! It offered both lightheartedness and heavy moments, and spoke to each of our core values: Mercy, Courage, Faith, Leadership and Dignity. If you have ever had the opportunity to work with Mercy Performing Arts, you know that these values are found in every project they undertake. These students are quite extraordinary, taking risks, stepping out as leaders, and caring for each other along the way. I was certain that our students would be able to relate to these remarkable women: these women who lived a lifetime before them, these Angels of Bataan.

These nurses, brought together by service, a hunger for adventure, or to escape the limited opportunities for women, left years later bonded by the trauma of war. Expectations of easy clinical work and leisurely strolls through paradise quickly became hell on earth: thousands of sick and wounded, without the supplies or manpower to keep up. These women, the largest group of females to be taken into captivity by enemy forces, worked tirelessly and in the worst conditions, to care for soldiers, civilians, and each other. This is a powerful message to our Mercy students. Individually, the Angels were capable, together they were a formidable force.

In closing, I must thank my own band of angels who have given so much of their time in helping us to make this production as authentic as possible, namely Playwright Tracy Wells, Nurse Practitioner Heather Lowry, and Platoon Sergeant David Neary who went above and beyond. Thank you all for your time and dedication to this project. It is my hope that our audiences are just as moved by the heroism and courage of The Angels of Bataan as we are.


