# Student Information

- Every student is expected to sell at least 6 books (30 tickets) of Sweepstakes tickets at \$5.00 per ticket or \$25 per book. Remember, this is only the minimum – Don't stop there! Additional tickets and envelopes will be available at the Reception Desk or the Advancement Office.
- Important! Each sweepstake ticket MUST be filled out completely. Ticket stubs (the small part) can only be returned with matching funds, either cash or check. Checks must be made out to Mercy High School. Be sure to fill out the front of the SWEEPSTAKES envelope completely. Please double check your tickets and money to make sure your count is accurate.
- You must fill out your name on the "sold by" portion of the ticket. If this is not filled out correctly, you will not be eligible for daily incentive drawings.
- Full payment must accompany each sweepstakes ticket in order to count for awards and our total goal. Turn in all collection envelopes to your Adviser during advisor group. Please keep all books STAPLED when you submit them. Make sure to fill out each ticket – not just the top one. If you come in late, turn in your tickets to the Advancement Office.
- **OUT OF UNIFORM** privileges do not begin until March 26<sup>th</sup> and only if you have received your lanyard. If you sell at least 7 books of sweepstakes tickets, you will be eligible for a Sweepstakes Lanyard. Incentives are not earned until verified by the Sweepstakes Committee. This will take one day. Your adviser will have your lanyard for you the next day if all your money is correct. This lanyard is your uniform pass and must be visible at all times. You are responsible for this pass! If you lose your lanyard, you must go to the Advancement Office to have a new lanyard issued (cost: \$5). Failure to have the required lanyard while out of uniform could result in a JUG. This applies to your shorts and leggings pass also.

# **LEGGINGS PASS**

\*\*\* New to Sweepstakes this year.

If you sell 80 tickets (16 books) you will earn a leggings pass.

If you earn your leggings pass you MUST wear a top that covers your bottom. If your top DOES NOT cover your bottom, you will LOSE your Leggings Pass and will not be able to get it back!
