This is a part time position receiving minimal supervision.

Responsibilities:

- Monitor standards of student behavior within the library/media center for the purpose of maintaining a safe environment conducive to learning.
- Provide instruction and assistance in the access and use of the library media center resources using the AML app.
- Assist students and instructional staff in identifying and accessing relevant print and digital information resources.
- Assist staff and students in educational technology practices to support iPad applications that substantiate learning.
- Achieve proficiency in operating a variety of media equipment: circ computer, printer, laminator and applications for the purpose of providing library/media services to students and staff.
- Participate in professional development training and staff and team meetings.
- Assist other personnel as requested.

Qualifications/Requirements

Library experience or Associate's Degree with certification as a Library Technician, and/or experience in educational technology. Possess knowledge of standard library functions, and computer and internet proficiency with ability to learn new software applications.
