Dear Mercy and Catholic Central Bus Riders:

To prepare for the 2018-19 school year, please review the 2018-19 Mercy Transportation information and time line.

June 12<sup>th</sup> General information and Request forms e-mailed & posted on website.

July 10<sup>th</sup> Due date for bus requests. Please return the completed form to Mercy with your non-refundable deposit. Deposits will be returned only to those families requesting stops

that we are unable to accommodate.

If you do not send the deposit, your application for transportation will not be

processed.

July 15<sup>th</sup> Contact will be made with individuals whose Bus Stop Request is deemed impossible.

If you do not hear from the transportation department by this date, you will receive a

bus route in August.

Aug. 1st Finalized Bus Routes e-mailed with Bus Rules. Bus Passes will be distributed by

drivers.

Aug. 17<sup>th</sup> iPad orientation.

Aug. 20<sup>th</sup> Ninth grade orientation.

Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> First full day of school all grades.

Catholic Central students may ride the Brighton-Milford-Novi Route.

Please use the enclosed route information to complete the Bus Request Form. **Completed bus** forms are due by July 10<sup>th</sup> with deposits.

A minimum of ten (10) riders, registered by July 10<sup>th</sup>, is needed in order to maintain the current routes or establish new routes.

### By Season

Seasons are August-November 15, 2018 (Fall), November 16, 2018- February 15 (Winter), 2019, and February 16-June, 2019 (Spring).

Round trip \$ 575.00 \$300.00 due by July 10<sup>th</sup>, \$275.00 due by Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>.

(\$ 4.79/ride)

One Way \$295.00 \$150.00 due July 10<sup>th</sup>, \$145.00 due by Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>.

(\$ 4.92/ride)

Winter Season Payments will be due by Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018; Spring Season Payments will be due by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

#### **Important Information**

- The Route Reservation Deposits are only refunded if bus stop requested is impossible.
- Bus Route request forms and first payments are due by July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The deposit/first
  payment is designed to insure sincerity of route request. If your new bus stop request cannot
  be met, and your family then declines to use the Mercy busses, your deposit will be returned.
- Winter Season fees will be charged unless you notify the Transportation Office in writing/email BEFORE November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. Spring Season fees will be charged unless you notify the Transportation Office in writing/email BEFORE February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
- Refunds for bus service due to change in circumstances (i.e., student turns 19 and begins driving, is in a sport) will NOT be available after the first week of the semester. The season passes should make planning easier. If your daughter/son is considering participation in after-school activities, please contact the Transportation Department for options BEFORE signing up for a pass.
- Catholic Central students: All Mercy Bus transactions will be handled by Mercy High School.
   Send all bus payments to Mercy.
- One-way and 10-ride passes will be available from the Business Office ONLY. If there is a lastminute need for a bus ride, the driver will take the information and pass it along to Mercy. The drivers will no longer accept any payments.
