



Parent Survey Results April 2020

 Mercy High School communicated with me and kept me informed as the E-LEARNING program was rolled out.








8. How much work is your daughter assigned during E-LEARNING?




9. How many hours does your daughter spend each day on homework assignments (not counting breaks from work)?





11. Do you have problems motivating your daughter to participate in her E-LEARNING classes?




12. How would you assess the overall current social/emotional well being of your daughter?





What Strategies Have Worked Well for Your Family with E-ELEARNING?

- Encouraging communication with teachers when my daughter has questions




Open Comments: What Could Mercy Do to Improve E-LEARNING?
